Changes to the Child Trust Fund website

From Friday 25 March 2011, the [Child Trust Fund internet site](#) will cease to exist. From that date, there will be a redirect message to take you to the Direct Gov website where the information will be held.

The information for Providers will remain on the HMRC website at [The Child Trust Fund](#).

The information on the Direct Gov site will be held at [Child Trust Fund](#).

On the Child Trust Fund site, the List of Providers held the trading and registered name, the address and contact telephone number for customers, the website address and type of accounts offered. The information on the Direct Gov site will be limited to the Providers' name and a link to their website, so when the change goes live on 25 March 2011, you may wish to check that your entry is and remains up to date.

CTF Annual Information Return for Tax Year 5 April 2011

Your annual return for tax year ending 5 April 2011 must reach HMRC by 4 June 2011.

You can find information on how to complete the return in Chapter 13 of the Guidance Notes for CTF Providers. This is available on this website at [Information for CTF providers](#)

If you do not submit your return by 4 June 2011, HMRC will not be able to accept any claims for repayment from you until you submit this return. You may have to pay a penalty if your return is late.

If you use a third party administrator to make this CTF return on your behalf, it would be advisable to bring this bulletin to their attention.

Please remember to put the correct period end date of 05/04/2011 on your return.
