## Footnotes

1 Most providers operate a 'cooling off' period of between 14 and 31 days when first presented with a CTF voucher; during this period the account cannot be reported as opened to HMRC. This means that the number of accounts opened is always less than the number of vouchers already presented to providers and awaiting the end of the cooling off period.

2 These statistics fall outside the scope of National Statistics

3 The number of accounts opened is the number of accounts opened to the 15th September 2006 of those issued in the stated time period.

4 Percentages in italics represent the final figure for that period as the remaining accounts for vouchers issued in these periods will have been allocated by HMRC.

5 These vouchers relate to children born between 1st September 2002 and 5th April 2005. These children received vouchers of between £256 and £277 depending on when they were born. Vouchers issued for these children are called transitional vouchers. Children born after 6th April 2005 receive vouchers of £250.
